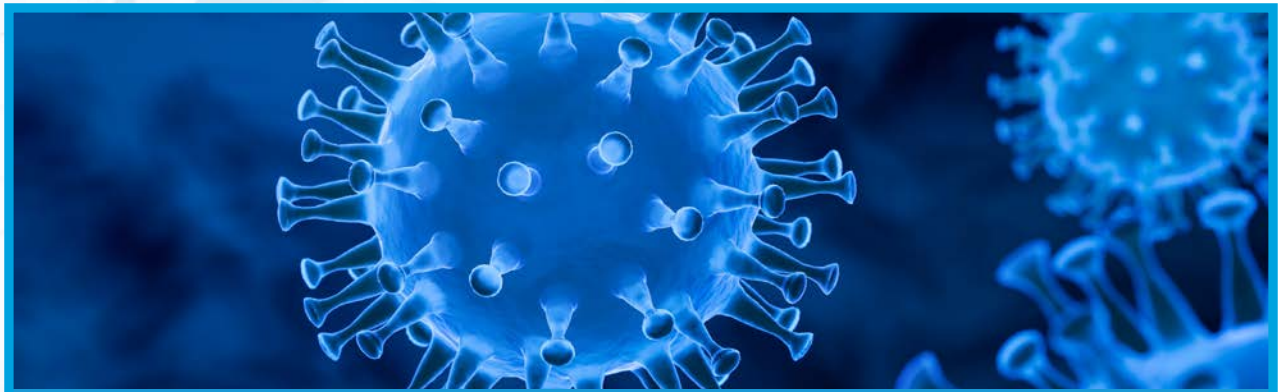
WCB Named Top 30 Employer in Manitoba
