<p>✓ A planing mill will normally process rough lumber before being sold as dimensional lumber at a retail level.</p> <p>The waste (sawdust, wood chips) may be used to make other products which could be classified elsewhere.</p>	<p>✗ Manufacturing rough-cut wood products is found under 311-02, "Manufacturing Rough-Cut Wood Products".</p> <p>✗ Building beams and trusses is found under 314-05, "Manufacturing Beams &amp; Trusses".</p> <p>✗ Treating or preserving rough-cut lumber is found under 311-02, "Manufacturing Rough-Cut Wood Products".</p> <p>✗ Operation of a pulp or paper mill is found under 31202, "Pulp &amp; Paper Mills".</p> <p>✗ Manufacturing finished wood products (e.g. siding, flooring, baseboards, casings, architectural and decorative mouldings) is found under 314-04, "Manufacturing Millwork &amp; Furniture".</p>
