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| <p>✓ Setting piles:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cast in place piles consist of concrete poured into pre-drilled holes. • Pile driving - a truck-mounted pile driver hammers steel piles, pre-cast concrete piles or wooden posts into the ground. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Drilling for wells is found under 202-02, "Water Well Drilling". ✗ Constructing a foundation, which may include incidental pile construction, is found under 407-06, "Excavation, Foundations, Installing Pools & Tanks". |
| <p>✓ Caissons (and cast in place piles) constructed to support the construction of bridges that are built across bodies of water.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Constructing a bridge, which may also include incidental caisson/pile construction, is found under 405-02, "Constructing Dams, Wharves, Bridges & Steel Buildings" or 408-03, "Roadwork". |
| <p>✓ Commercial diving services which may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • cleaning out under water intakes of large dams • inspecting bridges, dams or pipelines underwater • under water salvage <p>Work may include the use of under-water welding and cutting equipment.</p> | |
