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Section Title: Benefits Administration – *Healthcare Services*Subject: Out-of-Province Referrals for Clinical Examinations

Effective Date: May 29, 1985

A. POLICY

Referral of a claimant to out-of-province healthcare consultants or clinics may be authorized by the Workers Compensation Board, on request from a referring practitioner.

B. REFERENCES

The Workers Compensation Act, section 27

History:

- 1. Policy approved by the Board of Directors by Board Order 82/85 on May 29, 1985, effective immediately.
- 2. Minor formatting and grammatical changes were made to the policy and a history section was added, June 27, 2012.
- 3. Minor formatting changes were made to the policy February 2021.
- 4. In December 2022, the policy was updated to reflect the amendment and renumbering of section 27 by *The Workers Compensation Amendment Act* (commonly referred to as Bill 18).

C. ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

- 1. Generally, the WCB will not authorize referrals to out-of-province healthcare service providers when the same exam/treatment/procedure is available in Manitoba.
- 2. All referrals to an out-of-province consultant/clinic by a worker's attending practitioner must be pre-approved by WCB Healthcare Services before the worker is referred.
