Examples include:         <ul> <li>Department stores</li> <li>Hardware stores/home improvement centres/lumber yards</li> <li>Appliance and/or furniture stores, including "rent-to-own" outlets</li> <li>Home entertainment and electronics stores</li> <li>Flooring, carpet, lighting, drapery and other home furnishing stores</li> <li>Pool and spa stores</li> </ul> </li> <li>Includes incidental activities, such as merchandising, inventory and delivery to customers. In some cases there may be servicing of the products sold.</li> <li>Retail sales of cellular telephones,</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Specialty and smaller retail stores are found under 601-02, "Specialty Retail Stores".</li> <li>Retail sale of groceries is found under 601-06, "Independent Grocery Stores", unless they are large grocery chains, which are found under 601-04, "Grocery Chains".</li> <li>Retailing by a manufacturer is considered incidental to the main industry and classified accordingly.</li> <li>Selling vehicles is found under 604-02, "Automotive Sales &amp; Repair".</li> <li>Auctioning is found under 602-04, "Auctions, Appraisals, Picture Framing &amp; Rental Stores".</li> <li>Rental of furniture, appliances and tools is found under 610-03, "Light Commercial Equipment Rental Services".</li> <li>Store-front rental outlets can be found under 602-04, "Auctions, Appraisals, Picture Framing and Rental Stores".</li> </ul>
