Manufacturing complete aircraft or manufacturing or repairing structural aircraft components is classified under 320-02, "Manufacturing Aircraft". Servicing and maintaining own aircraft is
	incidental to the main operation, and is found under 503-16, "Aviation Services" or 503-17, "Aerial Spraying".
	The operation of an airport is found under 503-02 "Operating Parking Lots & Airports".
	Air transportation is classified under 503-16, "Aviation Services".
	Coverage for skydiving is optional and is found under 908-02, "Skydiving".
 Avionics - the installation, inspection, certification and other sales and service of aircraft electronics. 	Repair of non aircraft-related electronics is found under 315-25, "Manufacturing Electronics".
