Some examples of services provided include:         <ul> <li>Fire fighting</li> <li>Road clearing and maintenance</li> <li>Garbage collection</li> <li>Taxation and assessment</li> <li>Public transportation</li> <li>Animal control and by-law enforcement</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Some boards, committees or districts that are established for a specific purpose (i.e. conservation, watershed, planning, weed control, development corporations &amp; business improvement zones) are found under 801-03, "Municipal Boards &amp; Districts".</li> <li>Coverage for the operation of an Indian reserve is optional and is found under 902-13, "Operating Indian Reserves".</li> <li>Volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers are covered under 802-02, "Emergency Firefighters" or 802-03, "Emergency Ambulance Workers", respectively.</li> <li>Private road clearing or garbage collection is found under 501-03, "Waste Management, now Removal &amp; Towing".</li> <li>Private bus or "handi-transit" services are found under 503-09, "Transportation NEC".</li> <li>Private animal shelters are found under 714-03, "Veterinary &amp; Pet Services".</li> </ul>
