<p>✓ Operation of a conservatory (a greenhouse containing a botanical or natural display).</p>	<p>✗ Coverage for a commercial greenhouse is mandatory and is found under 103-05, "Greenhouses, Nurseries & Market Gardening".</p>
<p>✓ Operation of a zoo.</p>	<p>✗ A zoo operated by a town, city, rural municipality, etc., is incidental to the main operations and is found under 801-02, "Municipal Operations".</p>
