	In order to qualify for volunteer coverage, the charitable organization must:	
	<ul> <li>be registered as a non-profit organization with Canada Revenue Agency ("CRA") and provide the appropriate CRA registration number, and</li> </ul>	Coverage for emergency volunteer fire fighters is mandatory and is found under 802-02, "Emergency Firefighters".
	<ul> <li>have coverage in place for their regular workers.</li> </ul>	Coverage for emergency volunteer ambulance attendants is mandatory and is found under 802-03, "Emergency Ambulance Workers".
	Premiums are normally calculated based on the number of individuals engaged on an annual basis multiplied by a flat "head- count" rate.

## Relevant Exclusion(s): Workers Compensation Act of Manitoba

75.1 Non-profit or charitable organization and volunteers admitted A non-profit or charitable organization may apply to the board on its own behalf and on behalf of any person or group of persons who performs volunteer service for the organization to be admitted as being within the scope of this Part. The board may admit the organization and the person or group of persons, subject to any terms and conditions, and for the period, that the board considers appropriate.
