# **Industry Classifications**

# Sub-Group 924-03, Medical & Personal Services

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16(1) Provision of health care services by a physician, nurse, dentist, chiropractor, occupational therapist, optometrist, physiotherapist, podiatrist or psychologist.

- (This category does not include
  - (a) Those health care services provided in conjunction with a manufacturing or retail component; or
  - (b) Those health care services provided
    - (i) By a regional health authority or a subsidiary health corporation under the Regional Health Authorities Act;
    - (ii) By a firm that provides medical services at a hospital or home care services to the elderly or infirm, or

(iii)In a facility offering medical care and overnight accommodations)

16(2) Provision of optician or denturist services.
