### Relevant Exclusion(s): Schedule A, Regulation 169/2008, WCA

#### Health care services

16(1) Provision of health care services by a physician, nurse, dentist, chiropractor, occupational therapist, optometrist, physiotherapist, podiatrist or psychologist.

(This category does not include

- (a) Those health care services provided in conjunction with a manufacturing or retail component; or
- (b) Those health care services provided
  - (i) By a regional health authority or a subsidiary health corporation under the Regional Health Authorities Act;
  - (ii) By a firm that provides medical services at a hospital or home care services to the elderly or infirm, or
  - (iii) In a facility offering medical care and overnight accommodations)
